In this event, we will sell the special product "STOOL (stool)" which is made in celebration of the 10th anniversary of "more trees", a Japanese non-governmental forest conservation organization. The STOOL is designed by a collaboration of prominent designers, Jasper Morrison and Wataru Kumano.

"more trees" expected the special product "STOOL (stool)" to be something leads the organization to the future of forests in Japan and overseas through the theme "Connecting". Two are the perfect designers to embody what we want to realize.

Jasper has experiences accumulated over many years, universality brought about by his principle, "Super Normal", and global perspective based on his international projects. On the

other hand, Wataru is rich in ideas as a young and spirited creator, has affinity to wood and forest gained in his stay in Finland and Japanese perspective.

By two wonderful designers combining their unique talent and features, brand new product which is able to connect variety things, Stool, was born.

About “more trees”

“more trees”, a Japanese non-governmental forest conservation organization was founded by a renowned musician Ryuichi Sakamoto in 2007.

“more trees” plans and organizes various programs in aiming for a “society where forests and people coexist for generations to come” with a keyword in mind: “Connecting cities and forests.” Its programs include “More Trees Forests” – a collaborative work with local communities for conserving forests –, planning and development of products and services utilizing domestic timber, and sharing of information and charms of forests through seminars and events.

Born in 1959 in London, Jasper Morrison is a world renowned designer who designs widely from furniture and architecture to urban space. He studied Design at The Royal College of Art and Hochschule der Kunst in Berlin. He opened his Office for Design in 1986. He designs an ever expanding range of things at his studios in London, Paris and Tokyo, for companies all over the world.

It is “GOOD DESIGN STORE TOKYO by NOHARA” that he designed the interior for the first time in Japan.

<About the design concept for “GOOD DESIGN STORE TOKYO by NOHARA”>

“The basic concept of the design for GOOD DESIGN STORE TOKYO by NOHARA is to create a house with a front garden, the ‘walls’, in this case display shelves divide the space into various rooms which can be used to display different categories of object, while the garden at the front can be used to display new products, themes or small exhibitions.

The materials are a mix of warm and cold, maple woods structures, supporting aluminum shelves, connected with brass screws, standing on a concrete floor. This reflects the precision that many Good Design Award products display and the pleasure which well-designed objects bring to everyday life.”

■more trees design / STOOL

Size/Price : [S]JP¥10,584, [D]JP¥14,904, [L]JP¥20,304 (Tax included)

Stool comes in three sizes: Single, Double and Long. Three different sizes and shapes of stool are characterized by the beauty of the form. Just like music, it makes very rhythmic expression when arranging with plural. It links you and space as it fits in your lifestyle.

Stool is made of Tohno Hinoki from Gifu where one of the More Trees Forests is located, and made manually by local skilled craftsmen in the area. Tohno Hinoki is a representative Hinoki in Japan for having a good scent and a good strength as material and has been used for traditional buildings such as temples for a long time.

■Vitra / Trays, a set of three

At first glance, the Trays appear to be simple, flat dishes made of plastic. They were, however, developed by Jasper Morrison as a set of three, in carefully harmonised colours and sizes, in accordance with his 'super normal' design philosophy. The understated Trays tidy up any space while also adding a decorative accent.

Jasper Morrison successfully commercialized a lighting fixture based on Gifu Lanterns, a traditional craft of Japan, from the perspective of “The Beauty of Practicality”.

This work was born as the first of the project "LX. Project (LUX Project)" which designs lighting using traditional techniques of Japan. It was named Porcini family because there is three size that it was nicknamed the "mushroom" from the production staff.



■ **ANDO GALLERY, INC / ANDO'S GLASS S/T**

Koichi Ando from Ando Gallery asked Jasper Morrison, one of the premier product designers in the U.K. to "design simple glasses that we can use on a daily basis," and so, ANDO'S GLASS was born. Although it seems simple, ANDO'S GLASS, characterized by the slight inclination on the side of the glass, and the beautiful curve towards the bottom, in both short and tall variations, has a design that the longer you keep using, the more you like. This plain, yet delicate figure, created by artisans in an old town in Tokyo blowing into a mold piece by piece, stays with you quietly in your daily life and gives you delight every time you take a drink.

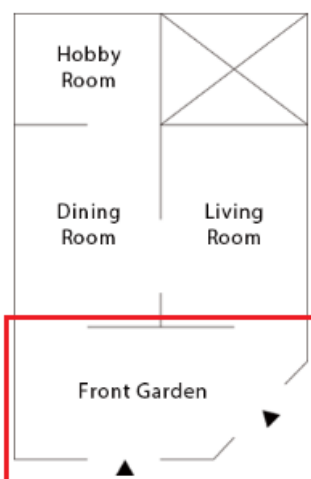

Its precursor, the Good Design Selection System (or G Mark System), was founded in 1957 by the Ministry of International Trade and Industry (the current Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry), and has been engaged in this work for about 60 years. Its history marks the milestones of Japanese industry and design. Since 2014, JDP has been operating Good Design Stores in Thailand and Taiwan to sell and promote Good Design Award-winning products, as a channel to promote Japanese design to the world. In addition, GOOD DESIGN Marunouchi was opened in Yurakucho Tokyo in 2015 as a permanent base for holding events and seminars and presenting contemporary design to the public.
